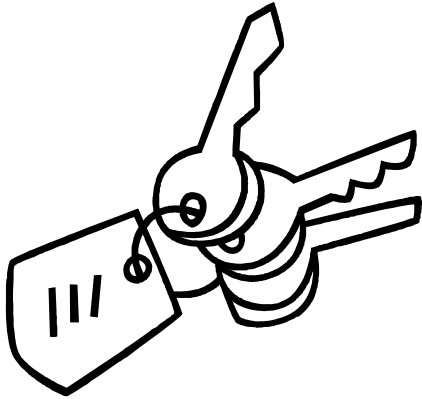

In recent years, America Saves, a program of Consumer Federation of America (CFA), and Consumer Action offered several car purchasing publications free of charge. Responding to the popularity of earlier publications and to recent changes in the car market related to the economic recession, we are now offering the opportunity to order **two publications on car buying**.
